At sea, Commander Beach served with distinction onboard USS Philadelphia (SSN-690) in Groton, CT from 2005 to 2009, during which he completed two CENTCOM deployments; onboard USS Oklahoma

City (SSN-723) forward deployed in Guam from 2011 to 2014, where he completed multiple operations throughout the Western Pacific; and as Executive Officer onboard USS Hawaii (SSN-776) from 2016 to 2018, where the boat conducted multiple Third Fleet operations.

Ashore, Commander Beach served as Flag Aide to Commander, Submarine Group TWO; Chief Engineer for Provincial Reconstruction Team Farah Afghanistan; Engineer Officer on the Staff of Commander Submarine Squadron ELEVEN; and, as Nuclear Officer Program Manager on the staff of the Chief of Naval Personnel.

His personal awards include the Bronze Star Medal, the Meritorious Service Medal (three awards) and the Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal (four awards).
